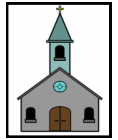
Should your child be unwell, please inform the school office on the morning of the first day of absence that they will not be in school that day.

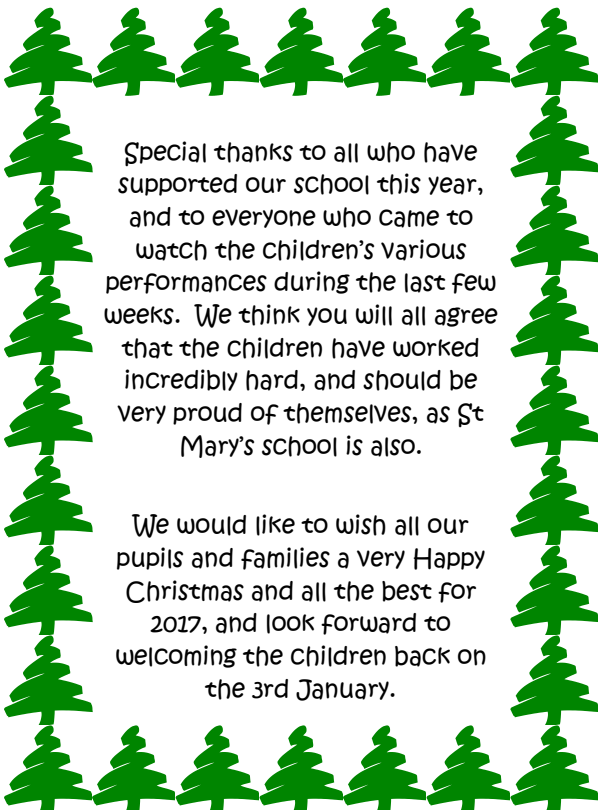

If any children from Y2 upwards would like to start taking violin lessons, please let the office know your expression of interest. Places will be first come first served as they are limited. Thank you.



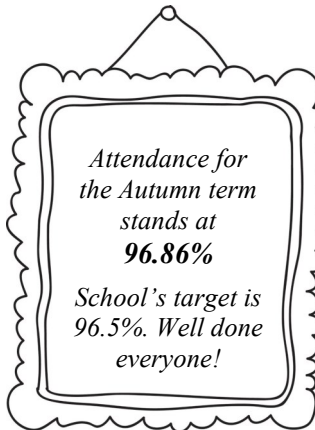
