YOUNG VOICES ITINERARY - Monday 9th January 2017

Here is a brief outline and reminder of how we see the itinerary for the day:

- The coach will be leaving school at approximately 12.45pm, and arriving at Sheffield Arena for approximately 1.30pm, with the concert itself going on until approximately 9.15pm.
- The rehearsal at the Arena will start at 2.15pm, and continue until 5.00pm when the children will take an hour for tea. Children will need to bring with them a packed lunch and plenty to drink for their tea. No glass bottles are permitted in the arena. Please do not send your child with any money for the trip.
- The actual concert starts at 7.00pm, but parents can begin to enter the Arena from 6.00pm onwards if they wish.
- All children will be travelling back from Sheffield on the coach, so parents will need to collect their children from the bottom of the school drive as they alight from the coach. No children can be collected from the Arena.
- Unfortunately we are unable to give an exact time for arrival back to school due to traffic, possible timing changes at the Arena, and the time it will take to get the children from the venue after the concert, and settled onto the bus. We will however, be back as soon as is possible, with 10.00pm being a rough estimate.

Dress Code on the day:

Please send your child to school in their school uniform as normal, as they will be getting changed into their Choir clothes before leaving school.

Dress code for the choir is as follows: Young Voices T-shirt, or alternatively a plain white t-shirt, black trousers (school trousers will be fine). For girls, if they prefer can wear black leggings. Please bring these to school on the day.
